The signal originates from the U.S. Steel Tower and emanates across two city blocks. Coverage area includes the U.S. Steel Tower’s upper and lower lobbies, the concourse eateries and lounge areas, and the entire outside courtyard. Users need only a laptop and wireless card to get online.

“With a fully redundant fiber optic backbone, users will experience speeds of up to 10 Meg, which is more than seven times the speed of the typical office T1 connection and up to fifty times faster than cellular WiFi service,” said David Schwencke, founder and president of Full Service Network.

“The U.S. Steel Tower is the place to get business done. When Full Service Network approached us with the idea, making the decision to move forward was easy” said Andrew Wisniewski, executive vice president of CB Richard Ellis, the exclusive leasing agent for the U.S. Steel Tower. “With over five miles of fiber optic cables and the addition of Full Service Network’s wireless zone, the U.S. Steel Tower is now unmatched for Internet connectivity.
